POPs and the Stockholm Convention

The Stockholm Convention is a legally binding international instrument, designed to lead to gradual decrease of the presence of persistent organic pollutants (POPs) in the environment.

There were 12 original chemicals listed in the document that were considered to remain intact in the environment and / or in living organisms for exceptionally long time periods.

This original list was added to with various amendments up to and including 2015.

Vitafoam do not use any of the POPs listed in the Stockholm Convention, nor those proposed to be listed, in the manufacture of Flexible polyurethane foam.
