Dear Customer,

The European Community Regulation No 1907/2006 concerning the **Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals** called "REACH" covers exclusively chemical components called **substances** and **preparations** which are used in the processing of final products or **articles**.

The European Authority requires that the substances and preparations supplied by the Chemical Supplier have been evaluated for each phase of manufacturing, conversion, usage and disposal of their products to demonstrate no danger for the environment or human beings.

Polyurethane foam products themselves are classed as Articles and therefore do not require to be pre-registered or registered.

We are obliged by Article 33 of REACH to communicate information on substances in our products if this product contain a substance meeting the criteria in Article 57 and identified in accordance with article 59(1) in a concentration above 0,1 % weight by weight.

We confirm that we do not use any of the substances being listed in the candidate list (SVHCs) of ECHA published on June 30th 2008 and updated July 16th 2019, in a concentration of above 0.1% and therefore there is no duty for communication.

We will keep you informed about any changes of that list if this is relevant for the products we deliver.
